I. Required Vehicle Equipment

A. Unmarked police vehicles will be equipped with:

- An emergency light, dash, visor, or window mount.
- A siren.
- A mobile radio transceiver.

B. In addition, unmarked police vehicles will be equipped with the following equipment:

- flash light
- gas card
- vehicle maintenance card
- seat belts
- spare tire and jack
- accident report kit

C. Sworn members are required to carry the following items in their vehicle or on their person (if certified to use):

- issued or assigned handgun
- handcuffs
- portable radio
- binoculars
- vest
- issued camera
- flex cuffs and cutter
- OC spray
- ASP Baton (if issued)
- badge and identification
- Cellular phone will be carried on the agent's person and turned on when the agent is on duty.
- raid jacket
- Exxon credit card. (Each employee has been issued a credit card to secure gas during operations outside the state. Employees should utilize the numerous state gas facilities when conducting business with-in the state. Employees should attempt to fill their gas tank at the last known gas facility before leaving the state on any operation.) If the credit card is used a receipt must be obtained and turned in with the proper paperwork, no more than five days after the completion of the out of state assignment. (Form: Appendix-J)
- Agent's/Inspector's investigative cash advance

D. Inspectors are issued and shall carry in their vehicle:

- Zeltex machine
- Sample cans
- Purge can
- Safety equipment (gloves, goggles)
- Williams test kit
- Dyed fuel testing tubes
- Stop sale packets
- Jacket
- Dip stick
- Bottom load adaptor (if assigned)
- Thieve (for bulk plant samples)
- Camera
- Fire Extinguisher
