



New EITC Assistant Launched

The Comptroller of Maryland has launched the new [EITC Assistant](#) to help taxpayers determine if they are eligible for the state's newly-enhanced Earned Income Tax Credit. This easy-to-use calculator is available in both English and Spanish.



Tax Deadlines Pushed

State income tax filing deadlines have been extended to July 15, 2021 for Tax Year 2020 to accommodate the [numerous changes made by the General Assembly](#). The IRS has also extended the federal income tax filing deadline to May 17, but many [other federal tax due dates](#), like estimated tax payments, remain April 15th.
