All products are hand-crafted in small batches at its warehouse to help customers find a path to inner and outer healing.

Mr. Franchot will conclude his stops at the Hampden Family Center, which has served as a hub for community activities for 25 years. He will present a proclamation to Executive Director Ashley Wilkes. The center provides a variety of programs and support services, including exercise classes, an after-school program, counseling, case management and support groups.
