**THE ECONOMIC IMPACT OF MARYLAND'S CRAFT BEER INDUSTRY** 

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### **COLLABORATIVE EFFORT**

- Driven by Self-Reporting of Maryland's Breweries
- Survey developed with input from Brewers Association of Maryland, National Brewer's Association, and other states
- Solicited and obtained participation with assistance from the Brewers Association of Maryland (e.g., association weekly newsletter, direct phone calls)

# **RESULTS OF EFFORT**

- 34 out of Maryland's 82 Breweries Reported
- Representative Population Sample
  Sample scaled to full population
- Entered Information into IMPLAN
  - Widely Used Economic Analysis Tool
  - Input/Output Model
  - Identifies Industry Specific Flows of Trade
  - Estimates the Direct, Indirect and Induced Impact

## DEFINITIONS

- Direct Effect economic activity generated by the industries that brew, distribute, and sell craft beer
- Indirect Effect economic activity generated through the supply chain
- Induced Effect economic activity generated from household spending resulting from above two effects

#### Notes:

- The above economic activity produces \$53.1 million in state and local taxes and \$55.3 million in federal taxes
- The above includes craft beer produced in Maryland
  - Including impact from out-of-state production, the total craft beer economic footprint is \$802.7 million
  - The economic value to Maryland is 54% greater per unit when the beer is brewed in Maryland
