SUBJECT:

Salary Schedules for Fiscal Year 2021 – Effective July 1, 2020

For the convenience of state agencies and state employees, we are enclosing updated Salary Scales reflecting <u>bi-weekly amounts calculated using FY 2021 as a NON-LEAP YEAR.</u>

To calculate the NON-LEAP YEAR factor, we divide 365 days by 14 (pay cycle days) which produces the 26.071428 bi-weekly factor. The Annual salary is then divided by 26.071428 to produce the new bi-weekly salary amounts (they will be slightly higher than the leap year bi-weekly amounts to accommodate for the one less working day 365 vs 366).

## Reminder:

Please pay special attention to the notes located at the bottom of several Salary Scales.
 Employees paid via Time Entry into the Workday Time Tracking system, may see a slight difference in their calculated bi-weekly rates vs. those shown on the Salary Scale itself. The calculated bi-weekly rates could be a couple of cents higher but should never be less than those shown on the Salary Scales.
